

Painters Registration - Business

About this Course

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to identify and comply with all regulations affecting the business.

It applies to individuals operating a small business who use analytical skills to interpret legislation and regulations and develop procedures to manage compliance and forms part of the requirements to achieve Painters registration in WA.

Pre Requisites

- CPC30611 Certificate III in Painting and Decorating or a relevant superseded qualification that equates to the CPC30611 or 5 years of experience in carrying out painting work.
- Must have a USI Number (www.usi.gov.au)
