

Painters Registration – Prepare Surfaces

About this Course

This unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to restore, repair and prepare different material surfaces for the application of paint.

The unit includes planning and preparation for the work, preparation of new or uncoated surfaces, preparation of previously coated surfaces, and preparation of previously wallpapered surfaces for painting and completion of clean-up activities. Along with Colour and Wallpapering techniques, forms part of the requirements to achieve Painters registration in WA.

Pre Requisites

- 5 years of experience in carrying out painting work
- Must have a USI Number (www.usi.gov.au)

Items required for class

- Highlighters (Yellow or Light Green)
- Fine Nib Colour Pen (red, Green, Blue & Black)
- Lead Pencils (1 x 2H & 1x HB)
- Eraser
- Calculator
- A4 Notebook
- Correction Tape
- Trade quality shirt or polo (100% cotton drill approx. 190gsm)
- Trade quality pants (100% cotton drill approx. 310gsm)
- Steel capped work boots (AS/NZS 2210) in good condition

- **82085** – PRB colour and wallpapering
