

Painters Registration - Prepare Surfaces

About this Course

This unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to restore, repair and prepare different material surfaces for the application of paint.

The unit includes planning and preparation for the work, preparation of new or uncoated surfaces, preparation of previously coated surfaces, and preparation of previously wallpapered surfaces for painting and completion of clean-up activities. Along with Colour and Wallpapering techniques, forms part of the requirements to achieve Painters registration in WA.

The Prepare Surfaces course is fully online and students will have an introduction module to complete which will enable students to navigate through the online platform.

Students will have access to a recorded conference which will guide you through the content and explain how to complete the assessments. A trainer will also be available to communicate with throughout the course during office hours.

You must upload your <u>pre-requisite evidence</u> when you enrol online. You will upload the information under "supporting documents". We will not accept your enrolment without it.
