Painters Registration - Estimate

About this Course

This unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to establish the estimated costs associated with the acquisition of materials and labour on building and construction sites, together with the application of relevant overhead costs and margins.

Knowledge of physical resource and supplier identification, assessment of the availability of and requirements for skilled labour and application of appropriate codes, regulations and approvals gaining processes is essential.

This unit forms part of the requirements to achieve Painters registration in WA.

- CPC30620 Certificate III in Painting and Decorating or a relevant superseded qualification that equates to the CPC30620 or 5 years of experience in carrying out painting work.
